

**U3A Campbelltown Inc. WALKING GROUP**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Friday each month during Term Time**

**Term 3 2019**

**Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July** - Catch bus 501 at 9:40 (Zone F) North-West Side of Paradise Interchange to Mawson Lakes Interchange where we walk down Dry Creek linear park to Park Way and return to the lake – walk around the lake, have a coffee, and back to the bus interchange and catch bus back to Paradise. 4.4 km

**Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August** - Catch bus G40 (Zone C) at **9:30** and alight at Stop 2 Goodwood Road where we walk across to the Parklands via Veale Gardens and Himeji (Japanese) Gardens stopping for coffee at St Andrews Hospital Café then on to Victoria Park and Rymill Park to catch a bus at Stop H1 Grenfell Street. 6.0 km

**Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August** - Catch bus J1 at 9:33 (Zone D) North-West Side of Paradise Interchange to Tea Tree Plaza Interchange then walk back to Paradise Interchange via Willowbrook Road and Dingley Dell. 5.9 km

**Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September** - Catch bus to City (Zone C) and take train to Ethelton Railway Station - walk past the new apartments alongside the river and past the old slipway area to Nelson Street bridge to cross Port River. Walk along the river frontage to the City of Adelaide clipper and return along docks by TAFE (stop for coffee at Folklore Café by Harts Mill) and cross Hart Street bridge to Ethelton Railway Station for return journey. 5.0km

**Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September** - Catch bus (Zone C) into the City then catch the tram to Glenelg. Walk along the Esplanade to Brighton Railway Station (Marlborough Street). Catch the train and bus back to Paradise. 6.1km

Walks commence at 9.30am sharp, so unless otherwise stated, please meet at Paradise Interchange by the Information Board (in direction of travel) at least 5 minutes before take-off time.

Parking is available at the overflow park off Crowle Road by the Influencers Church. (Stop 25A) or off the roadway between the fire-station and child-care centre.

On walks we will stop for a rest but please ensure that you bring water with you. Walking shoes are also essential. Be Sun-Smart and remember Slip, Slop, Slap!

Please remember to carry your Seniors Card with you for use on Public Transport and your U3A Badge with emergency contact details in case of an emergency.

Published walks may change due to weather conditions. If the weather is inclement, we can decide at Paradise.

Distances are approximate.
